**The effects of black locust on plant
species diversity****

Rationale/concepts

- Black locust (*Robinia pseudoacacia* L.) is among the most widely spread alien tree species in Europe
- It invades forest and open habitats
- Studies have highlighted contrasting results on the impact on understorey plant assemblages
- In Northeast Italy black locust influence had only a slight homogenisation effect on the ground-layer plant community
